Jesus Is God

- 1. By What the Bible Predicted** (Is 9:6; Mic 5:2)
 - Is 9:6 For unto us a Child is born; ...His name will be called... Mighty God...
 - Mic 5:2 "...out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting."
- 2. By What Jesus Said About Himself**
 - Jn 8:58-59 Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."
 - Jn 5:17-18 But Jesus...also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.
 - Jn 10:29-31 ³⁰ "I and *My* Father are one." ³¹ Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. (Jn 10:34-36; Mt 26:63-65)
- 3. By What Jesus Revealed He Could Do**
 - Mk 2:5-12 ¹⁰ "But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"-- He said to the paralytic, ¹¹ "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."
 - Jn 10:28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.
 - Jn 11:39-44 ⁴³ "...He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!" ... (Jn 20:30-31)
- 4. By What the Bible Reveals that Jesus Did Before He Was Born**
 - Jn 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. (Col 1:13-17)
- 5. By What the Bible Confirmed After He Went to Heaven**
 - Rom 9:5 ...from whom, according to the flesh, Christ *came*, who is over all, *the* eternally blessed God. Amen.
 - Phil 2:6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
 - Col 2:8-9 ⁹ For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily;
 - Titus 2:13 looking for ... glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,
- 6. By What Others Thought of Him**
 - Jn 20:27-28 ²⁸ And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"
 - Matt 14:25-33 ³³ Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the Son of God."
- 7. There Will Be No Mistaking Who He Is When He Returns**
 - Rev 19:11-16 ¹³ He *was* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. ... He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness ... of Almighty God. ¹⁶ And He has on *His* robe ... a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
 - Phil 2:9-11 ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow...¹¹ and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Why Did God Need to Become a Man?

- 1. Jesus Needed to Become a Man to _____ to _____ Us**

Jn 1:29-30 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ "This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.'
- 2. Jesus Needed to Become a Man to _____ the Law**

Mt 5:17 Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill.
- 3. Jesus Needed to Become a Man to _____ Us**

Rom 5:18-19 Therefore, as through one man's offense *judgment came* to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act *the free gift came* to all men, resulting in justification of life. ¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.
- 4. Jesus Needed to Become a Man to _____ on David's Throne**

Lk 1:32-33 "He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³ "And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."
