Man's CREATION (Gen 1:26-28; 2:15-25)

1:26-28 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." ²⁷ So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. ²⁸ Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

a. INNOCENT → Now _____ of sin

3:7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

b. NO SIN NATURE → Now _____ with sinfulness

3:12 Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate."

c. IMAGE OF GOD → Now _____

James 3:9 With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God.

1 Cor 11:7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, since he is the image and glory of God; but woman is the glory of man.

d. SPIRITUAL RESPONSIBILITY → Spiritual _____

3:9-10 Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where *are* you?"

¹⁰ So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

e. GENDER ROLES → Unaltered, but more _____

3:16-17 To the woman He said: "I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; In pain you shall bring forth children; Your desire *shall be* for your husband, And he shall rule over you." ¹⁷ Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': "Cursed *is* the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat *of it* All the days of your life.

f. MARRIAGE → Creates _____ between the genders

g. HAVE DOMINION → _____ ground, extra toil, and thorns

3:17-18 Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': "Cursed *is* the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat *of it* All the days of your life. ¹⁸ Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, And you shall eat the herb of the field.

h. FRUITFUL → Passes on sin and sinfulness to his _____

Eph 6:1-3

i. OUT OF DUST → Returns man to dust (_____ death)

3:19 In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken; For dust you *are*, And to dust you shall return."

j. CLOSE TO GOD → Separated from God (_____ death)

k. GARDEN OF EDEN → _____ man from the garden of Eden

3:24 So He drove out the man; and He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life.
