### Popular but Often \_\_\_\_\_ Verses in Romans 10:

**10:9-10** that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

**10:13** For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

### The Dangers of Quoting Verses...

- \_\_\_\_\_ may not be carefully examined
- \_\_\_\_\_ may be altogether ignored
- \_\_\_\_\_ may be non-existent or erroneous
- \_\_\_\_\_ of the intent of the verse may happen

- Ideas out of Scripture (exegesis) – He speaks
- Ideas brought into the text (eisegesis) – we speak
