<sup>37</sup> And as He spoke, a certain Pharisee asked Him to dine with him. So He went in and sat down to eat.

<sup>38</sup> When the Pharisee saw *it*, he marveled that He had not first washed before dinner.

<sup>39</sup> Then the Lord said to him, "Now you Pharisees make the outside of the cup and dish clean, but your inward part is full of greed and wickedness.

<sup>40</sup> "Foolish ones! Did not He who made the outside make the inside also?"

<sup>41</sup> "But rather give alms of such things as you have; then indeed all things are clean to you."

<sup>53</sup> And as He said these things to them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to assail *Him* vehemently, and to cross-examine Him about many things,<sup>54</sup> lying in wait for Him, and seeking to catch Him in something He might say, that they might accuse Him.
