

## The RESURRECTION of the Messiah (Isaiah 53:10-11)

### The ARRIVAL of the Messiah (53:1-3) \_\_\_\_\_ but \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>1</sup> Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?  
<sup>2</sup> For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, [There is] no beauty that we should desire Him. <sup>3</sup> He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, [our] faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

### The PAYMENT of the Messiah (53:4-6) \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>4</sup> Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But He [was] wounded for our transgressions, [He was] bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace [was] upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

### The DEATH of the Messiah (53:7-10a) – \_\_\_\_\_ TO \_\_\_\_\_ (for US)

<sup>7</sup> He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth. <sup>8</sup> He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken. <sup>9</sup> And they made His grave with the wicked-- But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor [was] [any] deceit in His mouth. <sup>10</sup> Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put [Him] to grief.

Rom 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

Gal 1:4 who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,

John 3:16a For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son...

• 10e \_\_\_\_\_ : God will prolong the days of His Son

Mt 28:1-6 <sup>5</sup> But the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. <sup>6</sup> "He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.

Jn 11:23-26 <sup>23</sup> Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." <sup>24</sup> Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day." <sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. <sup>26</sup> "And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

Rom 1:1-4 Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called [to be] an apostle, separated to the gospel of God <sup>2</sup> which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures, <sup>3</sup> concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, <sup>4</sup> [and] declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.

Rom 4:24-25 but also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead, <sup>25</sup> who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.

1 Pet 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead

• 10f \_\_\_\_\_ : God’s pleasure will prosper in the hand of His Son

• 11a \_\_\_\_\_ : God will be satisfied...

Rom 3:9-31

1 Jn 2:1-2 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. <sup>2</sup> And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

1 Jn 4:9-10 In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
