

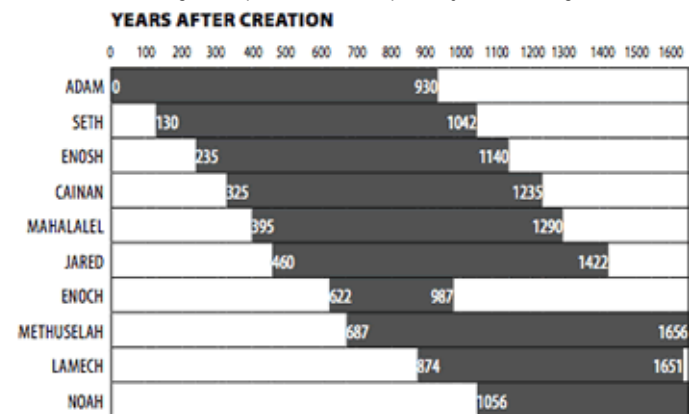
**Genesis 5:1-32 – From Adam to Noah – *Lessons from Individuals***

<p><sup>1</sup> This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God.</p> <p><sup>2</sup> He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• States a real genealogy of a real person (Adam). He is not a myth, but a real man who had descendants.</li> <li>• These two verses parallel Genesis 1:26-28.</li> <li>• God created Adam (and Eve), from whom all the earth is descended.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>3</sup> And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot <i>a son</i> in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth.</p> <p><sup>4</sup> After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>5</sup> So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• People produce people. God's image, though infected by sin, still exists. People, created in the image of God, are different than animals.</li> <li>• Adam had [other] sons and daughters, as did all the men in this genealogy.</li> <li>• Adam died, as promised in God's warning.</li> <li>• Adam lived 930 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>6</sup> Seth lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh.</p> <p><sup>7</sup> After he begot Enosh, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>8</sup> So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Notice this is just one line of descendants from Adam – Seth's line to Noah (without detailing any other descendants but that direct line to Noah).</li> <li>• Seth lived 912 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>9</sup> Enosh lived ninety years, and begot Cainan.</p> <p><sup>10</sup> After he begot Cainan, Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>11</sup> So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enosh lived 905 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>12</sup> Cainan lived seventy years, and begot Mahalalel.</p> <p><sup>13</sup> After he begot Mahalalel, Cainan lived eight hundred and forty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>14</sup> So all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cainan lived 910 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>15</sup> Mahalalel lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared.</p> <p><sup>16</sup> After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>17</sup> So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mahalalel lived 895 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>18</sup> Jared lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch.</p> <p><sup>19</sup> After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>20</sup> So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jared lived 962 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>21</sup> Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah.</p> <p><sup>22</sup> After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>23</sup> So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years.</p> <p><sup>24</sup> And Enoch walked with God; and he <i>was</i> not, for God took him.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It was possible to walk with God during this time.</li> <li>• Enoch lived 365 years.</li> <li>• Enoch did not die. God seemingly transported him into His presence (one of the very few that did not die).</li> </ul>
<p><sup>25</sup> Methuselah lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech.</p> <p><sup>26</sup> After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>27</sup> So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Methuselah lived 969 years.</li> <li>• Methuselah has the recorded as the oldest human being in the Bible.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>28</sup> Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son.</p> <p><sup>29</sup> And he called his name Noah, saying, "This <i>one</i> will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed."</p> <p><sup>30</sup> After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>31</sup> So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All of Lamech's ancestors above were still alive for some time after he was born!</li> <li>• Lamech is the father of Noah.</li> <li>• Lamech gave Noah his name for a specific reason, expecting Noah ("rest") to bring comfort to humanity.</li> <li>• Lamech lived a "short" 777 years.</li> </ul>
<p><sup>32</sup> And Noah was five hundred years old, and Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Noah had at least 3 sons.</li> <li>• Except for Adam, Seth, &amp; Enoch, Noah's ancestors above were alive at his birth.</li> </ul>

## Genesis 5:1-32 – From Adam to Noah – Lessons from Overall Observations

<p><sup>1</sup> This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God.</p> <p><sup>2</sup> He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created.</p>
<p><sup>3</sup> And <b>Adam</b> lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot <i>a son</i> in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth.</p> <p><sup>4</sup> After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>5</sup> So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>6</sup> <b>Seth</b> lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh.</p> <p><sup>7</sup> After he begot Enosh, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>8</sup> So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>9</sup> <b>Enosh</b> lived ninety years, and begot Cainan.</p> <p><sup>10</sup> After he begot Cainan, Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>11</sup> So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>12</sup> <b>Cainan</b> lived seventy years, and begot Mahalalel.</p> <p><sup>13</sup> After he begot Mahalalel, Cainan lived eight hundred and forty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>14</sup> So all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>15</sup> <b>Mahalalel</b> lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared.</p> <p><sup>16</sup> After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>17</sup> So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>18</sup> <b>Jared</b> lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch.</p> <p><sup>19</sup> After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>20</sup> So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>21</sup> <b>Enoch</b> lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah.</p> <p><sup>22</sup> After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>23</sup> So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years.</p> <p><sup>24</sup> And Enoch walked with God; and he <i>was</i> not, for God took him.</p>
<p><sup>25</sup> <b>Methuselah</b> lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech.</p> <p><sup>26</sup> After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>27</sup> So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>28</sup> <b>Lamech</b> lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son.</p> <p><sup>29</sup> And he called his name Noah, saying, "This <i>one</i> will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed."</p> <p><sup>30</sup> After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p><sup>31</sup> So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years; and he died.</p>
<p><sup>32</sup> And <b>Noah</b> was five hundred years old, and Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth.</p>

5. Longer lifespans impacted the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. Because of the longer lifespans, the population would have grown much more quickly, as people didn't die as soon, and likely had much larger families.
  - b. Because of the longer lifespans, one could possibly know 8-10 generations.
