

Christology 101: Jesus Is God

1. By What the Bible _____

- Is 9:6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called... Mighty God...
- Mic 5:2 "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting."

2. By What Jesus Said About _____

- John 8:58-59 Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM." ⁵⁹ Then they took up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple¹, going through the midst of them, and so passed by. (cp. Ex 3:13-15)
- Jn 5:17-18 But Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working." ¹⁸ Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.
- Jn 10:29-31 "My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father's hand. ³⁰ "I and *My* Father are one." ³¹ Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him.
- Jn 10:34-36 ³⁶ "do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?"
- Matt 26:63-65 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: Tell us if You are the Christ, the **Son of God!**" ⁶⁴ Jesus said to him, "*It is as* you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter you will see the **Son of Man** sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven." ⁶⁵ Then the high priest tore his clothes, saying, "He has spoken blasphemy! What further need do we have of witnesses? Look, now you have heard His blasphemy! (cp. Dan 7:13-14)

3. By What Jesus Revealed He Could _____

- Matt 28:18-20 ²⁰ "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age."
- Mk 2:5-12 ¹⁰ "But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins "-- He said to the paralytic, ¹¹ "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." ¹² Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw *anything* like this!"
- Jn 5:24-25 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life. ²⁵ "Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; and those who hear will live.
- Jn 10:28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

- Jn 11:39-44 ⁴³ Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!" ⁴⁴ And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."
- Jn 20:30-31 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

4. By What the Bible Reveals that Jesus Did _____ He Was Born

- Jn 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.
- Col 1:13-17 ¹⁶ For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

5. By What the Bible Confirmed _____ He Went to Heaven

- Rom 9:5 of whom are the fathers and from whom, according to the flesh, Christ *came*, who is over all, *the* eternally blessed God. Amen.
- Phil 2:6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
- Col 2:8-9 Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ. ⁹ For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily;
- Titus 2:13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

6. By What _____ Thought of Him

- Jn 20:27-28 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand *here*, and put *it* into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing." ²⁸ And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"
- Matt 14:25-33 ³³ Then those who were in the boat came and¹ worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the Son of God."

7. There Will Be No _____ Who He Is When He Returns

- Rev 19:11-16 ¹³ He *was* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. ... And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. ¹⁶ And He has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
- Phil 2:9-11 ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹ and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
