

## Christology 101: Jesus Is the Rightful King

### Jesus Is GOD

1. **By What the Bible Predicted** (Is 9:6 “mighty God”; Mic 5:2)
2. **By What Jesus Said About Himself** (Jn 8:58-59 “before Abraham was, I AM”)
3. **By What Jesus Revealed He Could Do** (heal, forgive, raise up, give eternal life)
4. **By What the Bible Reveals that Jesus Did Before He Was Born** (created everything)
5. **By What the Bible Confirmed After He Went to Heaven** (Titus 2:13 “God & Savior”)
6. **By What Others Thought of Him** (Mt 14:25-33 “Truly You are the Son of God”)
7. **There Will Be No Mistaking Who He Is When He Returns** (“every knee shall bow”)

### Jesus Is HUMAN

1. **First Promised in Genesis 3** (Gen 3:15)
2. **Foretold in the Old Testament** (Is 7:14 “virgin shall conceive and bear a Son”)
3. **Fulfilled in His Conception** (Mary – Luke 1:26-38, Joseph – Mt 1:18-25)
4. **Announced at His Birth** (Shepherds – Luke 2:8-20; Magi – Matt 2:1-2)
5. **Evidenced in His Life** (Matt 4:1-11)
6. **Evidenced in His Death** (Mt 27:35-53)
7. **Affirmed in the Epistles**
  - Rom 8:3 For what the law could not ... God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh,

### Why Did God Need to Become a Man?

1. **Jesus Needed to Become a Man to Die to Save Us** (John 1:29-30)
2. **Jesus Needed to Become a Man to Fulfill the Law** (Mt 5:17)
3. **Jesus Needed to Become a Man to Represent Us** (Rom 5:18-19)
4. **Jesus Needed to Become a Man to Reign on David’s Throne** (Lk 1:32-33)

Isa 9:7 Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Jer 23:5 "Behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; A King shall reign and prosper, And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

Dan 7:13-14 "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, *One* like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him. <sup>14</sup> Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion

is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom *the one* Which shall not be destroyed.

Mic 5:2 "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting."

Zec 9:9 "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

### What God \_\_\_\_\_ Through Human Lineage

- **Mary's Lineage** – Lk 3:31 *the son* of Melea, *the son* of Menan, *the son* of Mattathah, *the son* of Nathan, *the son* of David,
- **Joseph's Lineage** – Mt 1:1,6 The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham: <sup>6</sup> and Jesse begot David the king. David the king begot Solomon by her *who had been the wife*<sup>1</sup> of Uriah.

### What God \_\_\_\_\_ to Those of Jesus' Time

- **Mary** (Lk 1:32-33) He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. <sup>33</sup> "And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."
- **Joseph** (Mt 1:20) But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.
- **Wise Men** (Mt 2:1-2) Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, <sup>2</sup> saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him."
- **Apostles** (Lu 22:30) "that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel."

### What God \_\_\_\_\_ in the New Testament

- **Act 13:23** "From this man's seed, according to the promise, God raised up for Israel a Savior Jesus
- **Rom 1:3** concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh,
- **1 Tim. 6:13-15** I urge you in the sight of God who gives life to all things, and *before* Christ Jesus who witnessed the good confession before Pontius Pilate, <sup>14</sup> that you keep *this* commandment without spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing, <sup>15</sup> which He will manifest in His own time, *He who is* the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords,
- **2 Tim 2:8** Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel,
- **Rev 1:5** and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood,
- **Rev 19:16** And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. (Ps 24:7-10)
