1. The witness of _____ (the Holy Spirit)
John 5:30-32 - *I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me. "If I bear witness of Myself, My witness is not true. There is another who bears witness of Me, and I know that the witness which He witnesses of Me is true."*
(Also - John 15:26; 16:12-15; 17:23; 8:16)
2. The witness of _____ – Colossians 2:6
As you have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.
3. The witness of _____ – 1 John 2:6 –
He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk, just as He walked. Positional, relational truth – adoptive sonship
John 14:10 - *Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.* – The indwelling Father
