NKJ ²³ if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister. ²⁴ I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church, ²⁵ of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God which was given to me for you, to fulfill the word of God, ²⁶ the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints.

B. Suffering is accepted with joy as a temporary trouble for eternal gain

Salvation, Saints, Suffering, and Sanctification go together! Here are a few truths on suffering:

1. Sufferings Are Temporal and Tiny Compared to Eternity (Rom 8:18)

For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy [to be compared] with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

2. Sufferings Are Avenues to Knowing God's Comfort (2 Cor 1:5-7)

For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also abounds through Christ. Now if we are afflicted, [it is] for your consolation and salvation, which is effective for enduring the same sufferings which we also suffer. Or if we are comforted, [it is] for your consolation and salvation. And our hope for you [is] steadfast, because we know that as you are partakers of the sufferings, so also [you will partake] of the consolation.

3. Sufferings Are a Means to Knowing Jesus Intimately (Phil 3:10)

that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

4. Sufferings Are an Opportunity to Experience God's Deliverance (2 Tim 3:11)

persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra -- what persecutions I endured. And out of [them] all the Lord delivered me.

5. Sufferings Are a Necessity to Bring Us to Full Spiritual Maturity, as Illustrated by Jesus (Heb 2:10)

For it was fitting for Him, for whom [are] all things and by whom [are] all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

6. Sufferings Are a Means of Relating to Christ Through Experience (1 Pet 4:13)

but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.

7. Sufferings Are a Common Experience of All Believers (1 Pet 5:9)

Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

1. Affliction is normal every believer who follows Christ

John 16:33 "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Acts 14:22 strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting [them] to continue in the faith, and [saying], "We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God."

1 Thes 3:3 that no one should be shaken by these afflictions; for you yourselves know that we are appointed to this.

2. Additional affliction comes with spiritual leaders, as they care for the Body

2 Cor 1:8 For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of our trouble which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that we despaired even of life.

2 Cor 2:4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote to you, with many tears, not that you should be grieved, but that you might know the love which I have so abundantly for you.

2 Cor 7:4 Great [is] my boldness of speech toward you, great [is] my boasting on your behalf. I am filled with comfort. I am exceedingly joyful in all our tribulation.

Eph 3:13 Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.

Rom 5:3 And not only [that], but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;

2 Cor 1:4 who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.
