Therefore, if then you were raised with Christ,

- Be Seeking the Above Things (Col 3:1)
- Be Thinking the Above Things (Col 3:2)

Instead, Put On the Seven Articles of Clothing that a Believer is Commanded to Wear

3. Put on “Humility” by Choosing to Consider Yourself to Be a Servant to Others
4. Put on “Meekness” by Choosing to Approach Others with Gentleness and Consideration
5. Put on “Longsuffering” by Choosing to Give People Time and Grace to Grow
6. Put on “Bearing with One Another” by Choosing to Put Up with the Faults of Others
7. Put on “Forgiving One Another” by Choosing to Release Others from Their Sin Debts

Do Everything in the Name of the Lord Jesus Name reflects character

Col 3:17 “And *whatever* you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.”

Even, or maybe Especially, in Our Close God-Given Relationships, we should Uphold the Name of Jesus by Doing everything in His character

Though we all stand equal in Christ (Col 3:11), we still have various roles in the relationships in which God has placed us: wife to husband, husband to wife, children to parents, fathers to children, and bondservants to masters.

I. WIVES, _____ YOURSELF UNDER YOUR _____ AUTHORITY

Col 3:18 “Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.”

“Submit” ὑποτάσσω *hypotasso* means “to _____, _____ up, or _____ under.”

In the active voice, the term has a very militaristic connotation, and means to make subject, to subjugate.

1 Corinthians 15:28 “Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all.”

Luke 10:17 “Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, ‘Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.’”

In Col 3:18 the term is in the passive voice, “_____ yourself to be subject to.”

The word “submit” carries some heavy, negative connotations with it in today’s culture. Anyone who preaches on submission is considered a woman hater. However, this isn’t the only occurrence of the word in Scripture and women aren’t the only ones told to submit. Wives aren’t being picked on.

1. _____ should submit to _____.

1 Peter 2:18 "Servants, *be* submissive to *your* masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh."

2. _____ should submit to _____.

1 Peter 5:5 "Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to *your* elders. Yes, all of *you* be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

3. _____ should submit to the _____.

Romans 13:1 "Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God."

As much as modern society bashes anyone who preaches on "submission" as an outdated, sadistic, woman-hating barbarian, society itself would not exist without laws and submission to those laws.

4. _____ will be subject to _____.

1 Corinthians 15:28 "Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all."

_____ Himself submitted to His _____.

Luke 2:51 "Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart."

Submission itself isn't "evil." The struggle to submit is as old as sin itself.

Though Eve was created to be Adam's helper, her desire to act independently led to her being deceived by Satan, eating of the fruit, and giving it to Adam. Adam was cursed because he heeded his wife:

Genesis 3:17 "Then to Adam He said, 'Because you have heeded the voice of your wife,'"

And part of Eve's curse was that **Genesis 3:16** "...Your desire *shall be* for your husband, And he shall rule over you." Morris: "She who had acted independently of her husband in her fateful decision to taste the desired fruit, must henceforth exercise her desire only to her husband and he would rule over her" (*The Genesis Record*).
