<b>Requirement</b>	General Term Defined by the List	<sup>2</sup> A bishop then must be blameless,
<b>CHARACTERISTICS THAT ARE POSITIVE</b>	What He Must Be (6 characteristics)	the husband of one wife, temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, hospitable, able to teach;
<b>CHARACTERISTICS THAT ARE NEGATIVE</b>	What He Must Not Be (6 terms)	<sup>3</sup> not given to wine, not violent, <i>[not greedy for money,]</i> but gentle, not quarrelsome, not covetous;
<b>HIS CASTLE (HOME)</b>	What He Is to Be in His Home ----- <i>(the reason)</i>	<sup>4</sup> one who rules his own house well, having <i>his</i> children in submission with all reverence <sup>5</sup> (for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?);
<b>HIS CONVERSION</b>	What He Is to Be in Spiritual Age ----- <i>(the reason)</i>	<sup>6</sup> not a novice, ----- lest being puffed up with pride he fall into the <i>same</i> condemnation as the devil.
<b>HIS COMMUNITY REPUTATION</b>	What He Is to Be in the Community ----- <i>(the reason)</i>	<sup>7</sup> Moreover he must have a good testimony among those who are outside, ----- lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.
