# **How to Identify a False Teacher**

### 1. By Their Conduct

TITUS 1:15-16 - <sup>15</sup> To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. <sup>16</sup> They profess to know God, but **in works they deny Him**, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.

1 JOHN 3:10-12 - <sup>10</sup> In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: **Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God**, nor is he who does not love his brother. <sup>11</sup> For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another, <sup>12</sup> not **as Cain who was of the wicked one and murdered his brother**. And why did he murder him? Because **his works were evil** and his brother's righteous.

### 2. By Their Content

### man's teaching versus God's Word

MATT 15:1-6 - Then the scribes and Pharisees who were from Jerusalem came to Jesus, saying, <sup>2</sup> "Why do Your disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat bread." <sup>3</sup> He answered and said to them, "Why do you also transgress the commandment of God because of your tradition? <sup>4</sup> For God commanded, saying, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.' <sup>5</sup> But you say, 'Whoever says to his father or mother, "Whatever profit you might have received from me is a gift to God" — <sup>6</sup> then he need not honor his father or mother.' Thus you have made the commandment of God of no effect by your tradition.

COL 2:8 - Beware lest anyone cheat you through **philosophy** and empty deceit, **according to the tradition of men**, **according to the basic principles of the world**, and not according to Christ.

COL 2:16-23 - <sup>16</sup> So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, <sup>17</sup> which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ. <sup>18</sup> Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in *false* humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, <sup>19</sup> and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase *that is* from God. <sup>20</sup>

Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as *though* living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations— <sup>21</sup> "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle," <sup>22</sup> which all concern things which perish with the using—according to the commandments and doctrines of men? <sup>23</sup> These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, *false* humility, and neglect of the body, *but are* of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.

### denial of basic truths

GAL 1:6-8 - I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, <sup>7</sup> which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. <sup>8</sup> But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. <sup>9</sup> As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

Gal 2:3-4 – Yet not even Titus who *was* with me, being a Greek, was **compelled to be circumcised**. <sup>4</sup> And *this occurred* because of false brethren secretly brought in (who came in by stealth to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into **bondage**),

2 PET 2:1 - But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in **destructive heresies**, even **denying the Lord who bought them**, *and* bring on themselves swift destruction.

1 JOHN 4:1-3 - Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. <sup>2</sup> By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, <sup>3</sup> and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the *spirit* of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.

### adding to Scripture

1 TIM 4:1-5 - Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to **deceiving spirits** and doctrines of demons, <sup>2</sup> speaking **lies** in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron, <sup>3</sup> **forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from foods** which God created to be

received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth. <sup>4</sup> For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving; <sup>5</sup> for it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.

### 3. By Their Covetousness

MATT 7:15-19 - "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are **ravenous wolves**. <sup>16</sup> You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles? <sup>17</sup> Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. <sup>18</sup> A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor *can* a bad tree bear good fruit. <sup>19</sup> Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. <sup>20</sup> Therefore by their fruits you will know them

MATT 23:14 - Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you **devour widows' houses**, and for a pretense make long prayers. Therefore you will receive greater condemnation.

1 TIM 6:3-5 - If anyone teaches otherwise and does not consent to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which accords with godliness, <sup>4</sup> he is proud, knowing nothing, but is obsessed with disputes and arguments over words, from which come envy, strife, reviling, evil suspicions, <sup>5</sup> useless wranglings of men of corrupt minds and destitute of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain. From such withdraw yourself.

TITUS 1:10-11 - For there are many insubordinate, both idle talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision, <sup>11</sup> whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not, **for the sake of dishonest gain**.

2 PET 2:2-3 - And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed. <sup>3</sup> By covetousness they will exploit you with deceptive words; for a long time their judgment has not been idle, and their destruction does not slumber.

## 4. By Their Crowd-gathering

MATT 24:4-5 - And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. <sup>5</sup> For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.

### 5. By Their Causing of Division

ACTS 20:29-30 - For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. <sup>30</sup> Also from among

yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves.

### 6. By Their Commending Speech (Luke 6:26)

LUKE 6:26 - Woe to you when all men **speak well of you**, For so did their fathers to the false prophets.

### 7. By Their Conceit

2 COR 11:12 - But what I do, I will also continue to do, that I may cut off the opportunity from those who desire an opportunity to be regarded just as we are in the things of which they boast.

#### 8. By Their Outward Conformity

MATT 23:14 - Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense **make long prayers**. Therefore you will receive greater condemnation.

2 COR 11:13-15 - For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, **transforming themselves into apostles of Christ**. <sup>14</sup> And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. <sup>15</sup> Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also **transform themselves into ministers of righteousness**, whose end will be according to their works.

2 TIM 3:5 - **having a form of godliness** but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

### 9. By Their Conniving

2 COR 11:13-15 For such *are* false apostles, **deceitful workers**, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. <sup>14</sup> And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. <sup>15</sup> Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.

# 10. By Their Conflict

2 Cor  $11:25-26 - ^{25}$  Three times I was beaten with rods; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep;  $^{26}$  in journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of my own countrymen, in perils of the Gentiles, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren:
