<sup>7</sup> **Beloved**, let us **love** one another, for **love** is of **God**; and everyone who **loves** is born of **God** and knows **God**. <sup>8</sup> He who does not **love** does not know **God**, for **God** is **love**. <sup>9</sup> In this the **love** of **God** was manifested toward us, that **God** has sent His only begotten **Son** into the world, that we might live through Him. <sup>10</sup> In this is **love**, not that we **loved** **God**, but that He **loved** us and sent His **Son** [to be] the propitiation for our sins. <sup>11</sup> **Beloved**, if **God** so **loved** us, we also ought to **love** one another. <sup>12</sup> No one has seen **God** at any time.
