

The Book of Acts: The Holy Spirit and the Church

1. The Holy Spirit Communicated & _____

- 1:2 until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen,
- 2:17-18 "And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams. ¹⁸ And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy.
- 8:29 Then the spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot."
- 10:19 While Peter thought about the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men are seeking you. (cf. 11:12)
- 11:28 Then one of them, named Agabus, stood up and showed by the Spirit that there was going to be a great famine throughout all the world, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar.
- 13:2-4 As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." ⁴ So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they ... sailed to Cyprus.
- 15:28 For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things: (cp. 1:16; 28:25)
- 16:6-7 Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia. ⁷ After they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit did not permit them.
- 18:5 When Silas and Timothy had come from Macedonia, Paul was compelled by the Spirit, and testified to the Jews that Jesus is the Christ.
- 20:23 "except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. (cf. 21:4; 11)

2. The Holy Spirit _____ Believers [into the Body of Christ]

- 1:5 "for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." (cf. 11:16)

3. The Holy Spirit _____ Believers

- 1:8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me ...

4. The Holy Spirit _____ (Controlled) Believers

- 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- 4:8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: (cf. 13:9)
- 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.
- 6:3-5 "Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint...

- 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God,
- 9:17 And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."
- 11:24 For he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord. [Barnabas]
- 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

5. The Holy Spirit Was _____ to Believers

- 2:33 "Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.
- 2:38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- 5:32 "And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him."
- 8:15 who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit.
- 8:17(-19) Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. [Simon]
- 10:44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. (cf. 10:45-47; 11:15; 15:8)
- 19:2(-6) he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" So they said to him, "We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit."

6. The Holy Spirit Was _____ to by Believers

- 5:3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back *part* of the price of the land for yourself? (cf. 5:9)

7. The Holy Spirit Was _____ by Unbelievers

- 7:51 "You stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers *did*, so *do* you.

8. The Holy Spirit _____ at Least One Believer

- 8:39 Now when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away, so that the eunuch saw him no more; and he went on his way rejoicing.

9. The Holy Spirit Brought _____ to Believers

- 9:31 Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.

10. The Holy Spirit _____ Leaders

- 20:28 "Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God...
