 4. **The Genealogy of Luke Differs From the Genealogy in Matthew 1**
 - a. Matthew places it prior to his birth and Luke at the start of His ministry
 - b. Matthew's descends from Abraham and Luke's ascends to Adam and then God
 - c. Matthew focuses on the connection to Abraham. Luke focuses on the connection to Adam, and all of mankind.
 - d. Matthew's has 42 names and clearly makes a point of dividing in into 3 groups of 14 names. Luke's genealogy has 77 names in it.
 - e. Matthew appears to leave chronological gaps. This is a common practice among Jews, his target audience, who place a strong importance on genealogy.
 - f. Mathew lists women, Luke does not.
 - g. Matthew's and Luke's genealogies share lines from Abraham to David
 - h. Matthew Appears to Follow Joseph's Genealogy, Luke Appears to Follow Mary's Genealogy
 - i. Joseph provides legal standing as descendant of David
 - ii. Mary provides blood standing as descendant of David
 - iii. Jeconiah, king of Judah, and ancestor of Joseph, had his blood line cursed (his line could not sit on the throne)
