- 1. Satan's \_\_\_\_\_ Fall (and Future Fall Foretold): Is 14:12-15**  
<sup>12</sup> "How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! *How* you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations!  
<sup>13</sup> For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north; <sup>14</sup> I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.' <sup>15</sup> Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit.

- 3. Satan's Judgment at the \_\_\_\_\_: John 12:27-32**  
<sup>27</sup> "Now My <sup>soul</sup> is troubled, and what shall I say? `Father, save Me from this hour '? But for this purpose I came to this hour. <sup>28</sup> "Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came from heaven, *saying*, "I have both glorified *it* and will glorify *it* again." <sup>29</sup> Therefore the people who stood by and heard *it* said that it had thundered. Others said, "An angel has spoken to Him." <sup>30</sup> Jesus answered and said, "This voice did not come because of Me, but for your sake. <sup>31</sup> "Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out. <sup>32</sup> "And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all *peoples* to Myself."
  
- 4. The Holy Spirit's Conviction and Satan's Judgment: John 16:7-11**  
<sup>7</sup> "Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. <sup>8</sup> "And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: <sup>9</sup> "of sin, because they do not believe in Me; <sup>10</sup> "of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; <sup>11</sup> "of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.
  
- 5. The Purpose of Jesus – To Destroy the Devil's \_\_\_\_\_: 1 Jn 3:7-8**  
<sup>7</sup> Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous. <sup>8</sup> He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
