Jesus Is Presented as Messiah King to the Jews (Luke 19:29-40)

- ²⁹ And it came to pass, when He came near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mountain called Olivet, *that* He sent two of His disciples,
- 30 saying, "Go into the village opposite *you*, where as you enter you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Loose it and bring *it here*.
- ³¹ "And if anyone asks you, `Why are you loosing *it*?' thus you shall say to him, `Because the Lord has need of it."'
- ³² So those who were sent went their way and found *it* just as He had said to them.
- ³³ But as they were loosing the colt, the owners of it said to them, "Why are you loosing the colt?"
- 34 And they said, "The Lord has need of him."
- ³⁵ Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him.
- ³⁶ And as He went, *many* spread their clothes on the road.
- ³⁷ Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen,
- ³⁸ saying: "`Blessed *is* the King who comes in the name of the LORD¹!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- $^{\rm 39}$ And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."
- 40 But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

- a. Go to a nearby village
- b. Find a colt, tied up, and never sat on

- e. Speak this

3. The Disciples Obtain the Colt

- a. They go
- b. They find just as he said
- c. They lose the cold
- d. They are questioned
- e. They answer with Jesus' statement

4. Jesus Is Set on the Colt

a. The colt is led to Jesus

b. They throw garments on the colt

c. They set Jesus on the colt

5. Jesus Heads to Mt Olivet on the Colt

- a. They were spreading garments out
