

## Jesus Willingly Allows Himself to Be Arrested (Luke 22:47-53+)

### An Integrated Timeline of Jesus' Arrest

#### 1. The Background of Jesus' Betrayal

**Lk 22:1-6** Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread drew near, which is called Passover. <sup>2</sup> And the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might kill Him, for they feared the people. <sup>3</sup> Then Satan entered Judas, surnamed Iscariot, who was numbered among the twelve. <sup>4</sup> So he went his way and conferred with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray Him to them. <sup>5</sup> And they were glad, and agreed to give him money. <sup>6</sup> So he promised and sought opportunity to betray Him to them in the absence of the multitude.

#### 2. Jesus Affirms His Betrayal

**Lk 22:22-23** "And truly the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!" <sup>23</sup> Then they began to question among themselves, which of them it was who would do this thing.

#### 3. Jesus Retreats to Pray

**Lk 22:39-40** Coming out, He went to the Mount of Olives, as He was accustomed, and His disciples also followed Him. <sup>40</sup> When He came to the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation."

#### 4. Judas Gathers His Betrayal \_\_\_\_\_

**John 18:2-3** And Judas, who betrayed Him, also knew the place; for Jesus often met there with His disciples. <sup>3</sup> Then Judas, having received a detachment of troops, and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, came there with lanterns, torches, and weapons.

#### 5. Judas Arranges a \_\_\_\_\_

**Matt 26:48** Now His betrayer had given them a sign, saying, "Whomever I kiss, He is the One; seize Him."

#### 6. Jesus Returns from Praying

**Lk 22:45-46** When He rose up from prayer, and had come to His disciples, He found them sleeping from sorrow. <sup>46</sup> Then He said to them, "Why do you sleep? Rise and pray, lest you enter into temptation."

#### 7. Judas Betrays Jesus with a \_\_\_\_\_

**Luke 22:47-48** And while He was still speaking, behold, a multitude; and he who was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them and drew near to Jesus to kiss Him. <sup>48</sup> But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?"

#### 8. Jesus Secures the Apostles' \_\_\_\_\_

**John 18:4-9** Jesus therefore, knowing all things that would come upon Him, went forward and said to them, "Whom are you seeking?" <sup>5</sup> They answered Him, "Jesus of Nazareth." Jesus said to them, "I am He." And Judas, who betrayed Him, also stood with them. <sup>6</sup> Now when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground. <sup>7</sup> Then He asked them again, "Whom are you seeking?" And they said, "Jesus of Nazareth." <sup>8</sup> Jesus answered, "I have told you that I am He. Therefore, if you seek Me, let these go their way," <sup>9</sup> that the saying might be fulfilled which He spoke, "Of those whom You gave Me I have lost none."

**Mark 14:46** Then they laid their hands on Him and took Him

#### 10. The Apostles \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus

**Lk 22:49-50** When those around Him saw what was going to happen, they said to Him, "Lord, shall we strike with the sword?" <sup>50</sup> And one of them struck the servant of the high priest and cut off his right ear.

**John 18:10** Then Simon Peter, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.

#### 11. Jesus Corrects the Apostles

##### a. Not a Time to \_\_\_\_\_

**Matt 26:52** But Jesus said to him, "Put your sword in its place, for all who take the sword will perish by the sword.

**Lk 22:51** But Jesus answered and said, "Permit even this." And He touched his ear and healed him.

##### b. Not a Time to \_\_\_\_\_ God's Plan

**John 18:11b** Shall I not drink the cup which My Father has given Me?"

##### c. Not a \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Power

**Matt 26:53-54** "Or do you think that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He will provide Me with more than twelve legions of angels? <sup>54</sup> "How then could the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must happen thus?"

#### 12. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ the Religious Leaders

**Lk 22:52-53** Then Jesus said to the chief priests, captains of the temple, and the elders who had come to Him, "Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs? <sup>53</sup> "When I was with you daily in the temple, you did not try to seize Me. But this is your hour, and the power of darkness."

#### 13. \_\_\_\_\_ Is Fulfilled

**Mt 26:56a** "But all this was done that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled."

**Mt 26:31** Then Jesus said to them, "All of you will be made to stumble because of Me this night, for it is written: 'I will strike the Shepherd, And the sheep of the flock will be scattered.

**Zec 13:7** "Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, Against the Man who is My Companion," Says the LORD of hosts. "Strike the Shepherd, And the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones.

#### 14. The Apostles \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus

**Matt 26:56b** Then all the disciples forsook Him and fled.

**Mark 14:51-52** Now a certain young man followed Him, having a linen cloth thrown around *his* naked body. And the young men laid hold of him, <sup>52</sup> and he left the linen cloth and fled from them naked.

#### 15. Jesus Is Led Away

**Lk 22:54** Having arrested Him, they led *Him* and brought Him into the high priest's house. But Peter followed at a distance.
