# Life Principles from Proverbs: Fear God First

## 1. The Fear of the LORD Is the Basis for Understanding Truth

- a We must begin with the fear of the Lord to gain knowledge
  - 1:7 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge, *But* fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- b We must begin with the fear of the Lord to gain wisdom
  - 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
  - 15:33 The fear of the LORD *is* the instruction of wisdom, And before honor *is* humility.
- c Rejecting the fear of the Lord brings God's rejection in life
  - 1:29 Because they hated knowledge And did not choose the fear of the LORD, (see 1:22-30)
- d We understand the fear of the LORD through effort & time
  - 2:5 Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge of God.
    - <sup>1</sup> My son, if you receive my words, And treasure my commands within you, <sup>2</sup> So that you **incline** your ear to wisdom, *And* **apply** your heart to understanding; <sup>3</sup> Yes, if you **cry** out for discernment, *And* **lift** up your voice for understanding, <sup>4</sup> If you seek her as silver, And search for her as *for* hidden treasures; <sup>5</sup> Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the <u>knowledge</u> of God. <sup>6</sup> For the LORD gives <u>wisdom</u>; From His mouth *come* <u>knowledge</u> and <u>understanding</u>; <sup>7</sup> He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; *He is* a shield to those who walk uprightly; <sup>8</sup> He quards the paths of justice, And preserves the way of His saints.

## 2. The Fear Of The LORD Involves a Right View/Response to Sin

- a To fear God is to hate <u>evil</u> (knowing that God is <u>holy</u>)
  - 8:13 The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.
  - 23:17 Do not let your heart envy sinners, But *be zealous* for the fear of the LORD all the day;
- b When we fear God, we choose Him over sin in our actions
  - 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear of the LORD and depart from evil.

- 14:2 He who walks in his uprightness fear of the LORD, But *he who is* perverse in his ways despises Him.
- 16:6 In mercy and truth Atonement is provided for iniquity; And by the fear of the LORD *one* departs from evil.

### 3. The Fear of the LORD Brings Blessing and Benefits

#### a The Fear of the LORD Brings Confidence

14:26 – In the fear of the LORD *there is* strong confidence, And His children will have a place of refuge.

#### b The Fear of the LORD Brings Honor

- 31:30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.
- 22:4 By humility *and* the **fear** of the LORD *Are* riches and honor and life.

#### c The Fear of the LORD Brings Life

- 10:27 The fear of the LORD prolongs days, But the years of the wicked will be shortened.
- 14:27 The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, To turn one away from the snares of death.
- 19:23a The fear of the LORD *leads* to life, And *he who has it* will abide in satisfaction; He will not be visited with evil.

## d The Fear of the LORD Brings <u>Safety</u>

29:25 – The fear of man brings a snare, But whoever trusts in the LORD shall be safe.

## e The Fear of the LORD Brings Satisfaction

- 15:16 Better is a little with the fear of the LORD, Than great treasure with trouble.
- 19:23b The fear of the LORD *leads* to life, And *he who has it* will abide in satisfaction; He will not be visited with evil.
