BURNT OFFERING	A BULLOCK, OR A SHEEP, OR A GOAT, OR TURTLE DOVES OR YOUNG PIGEONS, ACCORDING TO THE ABILITY OF THE OFFERER. IF OF THE HERD OR FLOCK, A YEAR OLD AND WITHOUT BLEMISH.
