<sup>2</sup> "And Moses alone shall come near the LORD, but they shall not come near; nor shall the people go up with him."	<b>God Calls Moses to Come Near</b>
<sup>9</sup> Then Moses went up, also Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel,	<b>The Leaders Go Near the Mountain</b>
<sup>10</sup> and they saw the God of Israel. And <i>there was</i> under His feet as it were a paved work of sapphire stone, and it was like the very heavens in <i>its</i> clarity.	<b>God Reveals Himself to the Leaders</b>
<sup>11</sup> But on the nobles of the children of Israel He did not lay His hand. So they saw God, and they ate and drank.	<b>God Preserves the Lives of the Leaders</b>
<sup>12</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, "Come up to Me on the mountain and be there; and I will give you tablets of stone, and the law and commandments which I have written, that you may teach them."	<b>God Calls Moses <u>Up</u> the Mountain</b>
<sup>13</sup> So Moses arose with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up to the mountain of God.	<b>Moses and Joshua Go to the Foot of the Mountain</b>
<sup>14</sup> And he said to the elders, "Wait here for us until we come back to you. Indeed Aaron and Hur <i>are</i> with you. If any man has a difficulty, let him go to them."	<b>Moses Instructs the Leaders</b> a. <u>Wait</u> for us b. Aaron and Hur are in <u>charge</u>
<sup>15</sup> Then Moses went up into the mountain, and a cloud covered the mountain.	<b>Moses Ascends the Mountain</b>
<sup>16</sup> Now the glory of the LORD rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud.	<b>God's Glory and God's Waiting</b>
<sup>17</sup> The sight of the glory of the LORD was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.	<b>God's Glory from the People's View</b>
<sup>18</sup> So Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights. (19:3,20; here; 34:1,28)	<b>Moses' Time Up the Mountain</b>
