God Interrupts His Meeting with Moses, and Shares with Moses what has Been Going On in Israel's Camp...

<p>^{32:1} Now when the people saw that Moses delayed coming down from the mountain, the people gathered together to Aaron, and said to him, "Come, make us gods that shall go before us; for <i>as for</i> this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him." ² And Aaron said to them, "Break off the golden earrings which <i>are</i> in the ears of your wives, your sons, and your daughters, and bring <i>them</i> to me." ³ "So all the people broke off the golden earrings which <i>were</i> in their ears, and brought <i>them</i> to Aaron. ⁴ And he received <i>the gold</i> from their hand, and he fashioned it with an engraving tool, and made a molded calf. Then they said, "This <i>is</i> your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!" ⁵ So when Aaron saw <i>it</i>, he built an altar before it. And Aaron made a proclamation and said, "Tomorrow <i>is</i> a feast to the LORD." ⁶ Then they rose early on the next day, offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.
