<p><b>Deuteronomy 6:1</b> "Now this <i>is</i> the commandment, <i>and these are</i> the statutes and judgments which the LORD your God has commanded to teach you, that you may observe <i>them</i> in the land which you are crossing over to possess, <sup>2</sup> "that you may fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, you and your son and your grandson, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged.</p>	<p><b>1. God Gives the Purpose of the Commandments</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>God has commanded Moses to <u>teach</u>.</li> <li>The <u>purpose</u> of Moses' teaching. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That they would observe them in the land.</li> <li>That they would fear the Lord.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
<p><sup>3</sup> "Therefore hear, O Israel, and be careful to observe <i>it</i>, that it may be well with you, and that you may multiply greatly as the LORD God of your fathers has promised you -- 'a land flowing with milk and honey.'</p>	<p><b>2. <p><sup>13</sup> "You shall fear the LORD your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name. <sup>14</sup> "You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who <i>are</i> all around you <sup>15</sup> '(for the LORD your God is a jealous God among you), lest the anger of the LORD your God be aroused against you and destroy you from the face of the earth. <sup>16</sup> " You shall not tempt the LORD your God as you tempted <i>Him</i> in Massah. <sup>17</sup> "You shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, His testimonies, and His statutes which He has commanded you. <sup>18</sup> "And you shall do <i>what is</i> right and good in the sight of the LORD, that it may be well with you, and that you may go in and possess the good land of which the LORD swore to your fathers, <sup>19</sup> "to cast out all your enemies from before you, as the LORD has spoken.</p>	<p><b>6.
