<p><b>Deuteronomy 22:1-4</b> "You shall not see your brother's ox or his sheep going astray, and hide yourself from them; you shall certainly bring them back to your brother. <sup>2</sup> "And if your brother <i>is</i> not near you, or if you do not know him, then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall remain with you until your brother seeks it; then you shall restore it to him. <sup>3</sup> "You shall do the same with his donkey, and so shall you do with his garment; with any lost thing of your brother's, which he has lost and you have found, you shall do likewise; you must not hide yourself. <sup>4</sup> " You shall not see your brother's donkey or his ox fall down along the road, and hide yourself from them; you shall surely help him lift <i>them</i> up again.</p>	<p><b>1. God Gives Israel a responsibility to _____ for Each Other.</b>  <b>Exodus 23:4-5</b> <sup>4</sup> " If you meet your enemy's ox or his donkey going astray, you shall surely bring it back to him again. <sup>5</sup> "If you see the donkey of one who hates you lying under its burden, and you would refrain from helping it, you shall surely help him with it.</p>
<p><sup>5</sup> " A woman shall not wear anything that pertains to a man, nor shall a man put on a woman's garment, for all who do so <i>are</i> an abomination to the LORD your God.</p>	<p><b>2. God Commands Men and Women to Be _____.</b>  <b>Genesis 1:27</b> <sup>27</sup> So God created man in His <i>own</i> image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. (Gen.2)</p>
<p><sup>6</sup> " If a bird's nest happens to be before you along the way, in any tree or on the ground, with young ones or eggs, with the mother sitting on the young or on the eggs, you shall not take the mother with the young; <sup>7</sup> "you shall surely let the mother go, and take the young for yourself, that it may be well with you and <i>that</i> you may prolong <i>your</i> days.</p>	<p><b>3. God Instructs Israel to Be Responsible with _____ Creation.</b>  <b>Leviticus 22:28</b> <sup>28</sup> "<i>Whether it is</i> a cow or ewe, do not kill both her and her young on the same day.</p>
<p><sup>8</sup> " When you build a new house, then you shall make a parapet for your roof, that you may not bring guilt of bloodshed on your household if anyone falls from it.</p>	<p><b>4. God Instructs Israel to Be Responsible with _____ Creation.</b></p>
<p><sup>9</sup> " You shall not sow your vineyard with different kinds of seed, lest the yield of the seed which you have sown and the fruit of your vineyard be defiled. <sup>10</sup> " You shall not plow with an ox and a donkey together. <sup>11</sup> " You shall not wear a garment of different sorts, <i>such as</i> wool and linen mixed together.</p>	<p><b>5. God Commands _____ in Israel's Activity.</b>  <b>Leviticus 19:19</b> <sup>19</sup> ' You shall keep My statutes. You shall not let your livestock breed with another kind. You shall not sow your field with mixed seed. Nor shall a garment of mixed linen and wool come upon you.</p>
<p><sup>12</sup> " You shall make tassels on the four corners of the clothing with which you cover <i>yourself</i>.</p>	<p><b>6. God Instructs Israel in What They Should _____</b>  <b>Numbers 15:38-40</b> <sup>38</sup> "Speak to the children of Israel: Tell them to make tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and to put a blue thread in the tassels of the corners. <sup>39</sup> "And you shall have the <b>tassel</b>, that you may look upon it and remember all the commandments of the LORD and do them, and that you</p>

	<p>may not follow the harlotry to which your own heart and your own eyes are inclined, <sup>40</sup> "and that you may remember and do all My commandments, and be holy for your God.</p>
<p><sup>13</sup> " If any man takes a wife, and goes in to her, and detests her, <sup>14</sup> "and charges her with shameful conduct, and brings a bad name on her, and says, 'I took this woman, and when I came to her I found she <i>was</i> not a virgin,' <sup>15</sup> "then the father and mother of the young woman shall take and bring out <i>the evidence of</i> the young woman's virginity to the elders of the city at the gate. <sup>16</sup> "And the young woman's father shall say to the elders, 'I gave my daughter to this man as wife, and he detests her. <sup>17</sup> 'Now he has charged her with shameful conduct, saying, "I found your daughter <i>was</i> not a virgin," and yet these <i>are the evidences of</i> my daughter's virginity.' And they shall spread the cloth before the elders of the city. <sup>18</sup> "Then the elders of that city shall take that man and punish him; <sup>19</sup> "and they shall fine him one hundred <i>shekels</i> of silver and give <i>them</i> to the father of the young woman, because he has brought a bad name on a virgin of Israel. And she shall be his wife; he cannot divorce her all his days. <sup>20</sup> "But if the thing is true, <i>and evidences of</i> virginity are not found for the young woman, <sup>21</sup> "then they shall bring out the young woman to the door of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her to death with stones, because she has done a disgraceful thing in Israel, to play the harlot in her father's house. So you shall put away the evil from among you.</p>	<p><b>7. God Gives Instructions Concerning How to Respond to Issues of _____.</b>  <b>Leviticus 20:10</b> <sup>10</sup> 'The man who commits adultery with <i>another</i> man's wife, <i>he</i> who commits adultery with his neighbor's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress, shall surely be put to death.  <b>Matt. 19</b></p>
<p><sup>23</sup> " If a young woman <i>who is</i> a virgin is betrothed to a husband, and a man finds her in the city and lies with her, <sup>24</sup> "then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city, and you shall stone them to death with stones, the young woman because she did not cry out in the city, and the man because he humbled his neighbor's wife; so you shall put away the evil from among you. <sup>25</sup> " But if a man finds a betrothed young woman in the countryside, and the man forces her and lies with her, then only the man who lay with her shall die. <sup>26</sup> "But you shall do nothing to the young woman; <i>there is</i> in the young woman no sin <i>deserving</i> of death, for just as when a man rises against his neighbor and kills him, even so <i>is</i> this matter. <sup>27</sup> "For he found her in the countryside, <i>and</i> the betrothed young woman cried out, but <i>there was</i> no one to save her. <sup>28</sup> " If a man finds a young woman <i>who is</i> a virgin, who is not betrothed, and he seizes her and lies with her, and they are found out, <sup>29</sup> "then the man who lay with her shall give to the young woman's father fifty <i>shekels</i> of silver, and she shall be his wife because he has humbled her; he shall not be permitted to divorce her all his days.</p>	<p><b>8. God Gives Instruction Concerning How to Respond to _____.</b></p>
<p><sup>30</sup> " A man shall not take his father's wife, nor uncover his father's bed.</p>	<p><b>9. God gives Instructions to Remain _____.</b>  <b>Leviticus 20:11-14</b> <sup>11</sup> 'The man who lies with his father's wife has uncovered his father's nakedness; both of them shall surely be put to death. Their blood <i>shall be</i> upon them. <sup>12</sup> 'If a man lies with his daughter-in-law, both of them shall surely be put to death. They have committed perversion. Their blood <i>shall be</i> upon them. <sup>13</sup> 'If a man lies with a male as he lies with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination. They shall surely be put to death. Their blood <i>shall be</i> upon them. <sup>14</sup> 'If a man</p>

	marries a woman and her mother, it <i>is</i> wickedness. They shall be burned with fire, both he and they, that there may be no wickedness among you.
<b>Deuteronomy 23:1-6</b> "He who is emasculated by crushing or mutilation shall not enter the assembly of the LORD. <sup>2</sup> " One of illegitimate birth shall not enter the assembly of the LORD; even to the tenth generation none of his <i>descendants</i> shall enter the assembly of the LORD. <sup>3</sup> " An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter the assembly of the LORD; even to the tenth generation none of his <i>descendants</i> shall enter the assembly of the LORD forever, <sup>4</sup> "because they did not meet you with bread and water on the road when you came out of Egypt, and because they hired against you Balaam the son of Beor from Pethor of Mesopotamia, to curse you. <sup>5</sup> "Nevertheless the LORD your God would not listen to Balaam, but the LORD your God turned the curse into a blessing for you, because the LORD your God loves you. <sup>6</sup> "You shall not seek their peace nor their prosperity all your days forever.	<b>10. God Lists Those Who May Not _____ the Assembly of the Lord.</b>
<sup>7</sup> " You shall not abhor an Edomite, for he <i>is</i> your brother. You shall not abhor an Egyptian, because you were an alien in his land. <sup>8</sup> "The children of the third generation born to them may enter the assembly of the LORD.	<b>11. God Allows Edomites and Egyptians to _____ the Assembly of the Lord.</b>
<sup>9</sup> " When the army goes out against your enemies, then keep yourself from every wicked thing.	<b>12. God Commands Purity During _____.</b>
<sup>10</sup> "If there is any man among you who becomes unclean by some occurrence in the night, then he shall go outside the camp; he shall not come inside the camp. <sup>11</sup> "But it shall be, when evening comes, that he shall wash with water; and when the sun sets, he may come into the camp. <sup>12</sup> "Also you shall have a place outside the camp, where you may go out; <sup>13</sup> "and you shall have an implement among your equipment, and when you sit down outside, you shall dig with it and turn and cover your refuse. <sup>14</sup> "For the LORD your God walks in the midst of your camp, to deliver you and give your enemies over to you; therefore your camp shall be holy, that He may see no unclean thing among you, and turn away from you.	<b>13. God Instructs How to Deal with _____.</b> <b>Numbers 5:2-3</b> <sup>2</sup> "Command the children of Israel that they put out of the camp every leper, everyone who has a discharge, and whoever becomes defiled by a corpse. <sup>3</sup> "You shall put out both male and female; you shall put them outside the camp, that they may not defile their camps in the midst of which I dwell."
<sup>15</sup> " You shall not give back to his master the slave who has escaped from his master to you. <sup>16</sup> "He may dwell with you in your midst, in the place which he chooses within one of your gates, where it seems best to him; you shall not oppress him.	<b>14. God Instructs How to Deal with _____ Slaves.</b> <b>Exodus 21:2</b> <sup>2</sup> "If you buy a Hebrew servant, he shall serve six years; and in the seventh he shall go out free and pay nothing. <b>Deuteronomy 15:12</b> <sup>12</sup> " If your brother, a Hebrew man, or a Hebrew woman, is sold to you and serves you six years, then in the seventh year you shall let him go free from you.
<sup>17</sup> " There shall be no <i>ritual</i> harlot of the daughters of Israel, or a perverted one of the sons of Israel. <sup>18</sup> "You shall not bring the wages of a harlot or the price of a dog to the house of the LORD your God for any vowed offering, for both of these <i>are</i> an abomination to the LORD your God.	<b>15. God Forbids _____.</b> <b>Revelation 22:14-15</b> <sup>14</sup> Blessed <i>are</i> those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. <sup>15</sup> But outside <i>are</i> dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.
<sup>19</sup> " You shall not charge interest to your brother -- interest on money <i>or</i> food <i>or</i> anything that is lent out at interest. <sup>20</sup> "To a foreigner you may charge interest, but to your brother you shall not charge interest, that the LORD your God may bless you in all to which you set your hand in the land which you are entering to possess.	<b>16. God's Instruction for Charging _____.</b> <b>Exodus 22:25</b> <sup>25</sup> " If you lend money to <i>any of</i> My people <i>who are</i> poor among you, you shall not be like a moneylender to him; you shall not charge him interest.

<p><sup>21</sup> " When you make a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not delay to pay it; for the LORD your God will surely require it of you, and it would be sin to you. <sup>22</sup> "But if you abstain from vowing, it shall not be sin to you. <sup>23</sup> "That which has gone from your lips you shall keep and perform, for you voluntarily vowed to the LORD your God what you have promised with your mouth.</p>	<p><b>17. God's Instruction Concerning _____.</b>  <b>Lev. 27;</b>  <b>Numbers 30:2</b> <sup>2</sup> "If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.</p>
<p><sup>24</sup> " When you come into your neighbor's vineyard, you may eat your fill of grapes at your pleasure, but you shall not put <i>any</i> in your container. <sup>25</sup> "When you come into your neighbor's standing grain, you may pluck the heads with your hand, but you shall not use a sickle on your neighbor's standing grain.</p>	<p><b>18. God Allows for _____ of Crops.</b>  <b>Matthew 12:1-2</b> At that time Jesus went through the grainfields on the Sabbath. And His disciples were hungry, and began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. <sup>2</sup> And when the Pharisees saw <i>it</i>, they said to Him, "Look, Your disciples are doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath!"</p>
