

Timeline of Truth – North and South Conquest and Review of Conquered Areas (Joshua 10:28-13:6)

1. Joshua's Continued _____ (Joshua 10:28-43)

⁴² All these kings and their land Joshua took at one time, because the LORD God of Israel fought for Israel. ⁴³

Then Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, to the camp at Gilgal.

- A. Joshua continues to conquer the kings and the cities of the kings in the alliance.
- B. Joshua conquers all the lands:
 - 1. The mountain county
 - 2. The south
 - 3. The lowlands
 - 4. The wilderness slope
- C. Joshua was able to conquer these all at once
 - 1. Because the Lord God fought for Israel (vs. 42)
 - 2. Joshua returned to Gilgal (by the Jordan)

2. Joshua _____ a Second Alliance of Kings (Joshua 11:1-12)

⁶ But the LORD said to Joshua, "Do not be afraid because of them, for tomorrow about this time I will deliver all of them slain before Israel. You shall hamstring their horses and burn their chariots with fire."

- A. This was a group of northern king.
- B. God promises to deliver the kings into Joshua's hand
 - 1. Do not be afraid
 - 2. God will do this the next day
 - 3. Joshua will even defeat the horses and chariots
- C. Joshua obeyed the Lord
- D. Hazor and the cities of the other kings were utterly destroyed

3. The _____ of Joshua's Conquest (Joshua 11:13-20)

- A. Only one of the mound cities were destroyed
- B. Israel took the material things and the livestock but killed the people.
- C. They did as God commanded Moses
- D. The war went on a long time

Deuteronomy 1:26-28 ²⁶ "Nevertheless you would not go up, but rebelled against the command of the LORD your God; ²⁷ "and you complained in your tents, and said, 'Because the LORD hates us, He has brought us out of the land of Egypt to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us. ²⁸ 'Where can we go up? Our brethren have discouraged our hearts, saying, "The people *are* greater and taller than we; the cities *are* great and fortified up to heaven; moreover we have seen the sons of the Anakim there." "

Deuteronomy 9:1-3 "Hear, O Israel: You *are* to cross over the Jordan today, and go in to dispossess nations greater and mightier than yourself, cities great and fortified up to heaven, ² "a people great and tall, the descendants of the Anakim, whom you know, and *of whom* you heard *it said*, 'Who can stand before the descendants of Anak?' ³ "Therefore understand today that the LORD your God *is* He who goes over before you *as* a consuming fire. He will destroy them and bring them down before you; so you shall drive them out and destroy them quickly as the LORD has said to you.

- B. Joshua took the whole land
 - 1. According to what God promised to Moses
 - 2. Joshua divided the land
 - 3. The land rested from war

5. Moses' _____ Reviewed (12:1-6)

- A. This was east of the Jordan
- B. It was given to the Reubenites, Gadites and half the tribe of Manasseh

6. The _____ Kings Reviewed (Joshua 12:7-24)

- A. All the conquered kings are listed
- B. Joshua conquered 31 kings

7. Review of the Lands _____ to be Conquered (Joshua 13:1-6)

Joshua 13:1-6 Now Joshua was old, advanced in years. And the LORD said to him: "You are old, advanced in years, and there remains very much land yet to be possessed. ² "This is the land that yet remains: all the territory of the Philistines and all *that of* the Geshurites, ³ "from Sihor, which *is* east of Egypt, as far as the border of Ekron northward (*which* is counted as Canaanite); the five lords of the Philistines -- the Gazites, the Ashdodites, the Ashkelonites, the Gittites, and the Ekronites; also the Avites; ⁴ "from the south, all the land of the Canaanites, and Mearah that belongs to the Sidonians as far as Aphek, to the border of the Amorites; ⁵ "the land of the Gebalites, and all Lebanon, toward the sunrise, from Baal Gad below Mount Hermon as far as the entrance to Hamath; ⁶ "all the inhabitants of the mountains from Lebanon as far as the Brook Misrephoth, *and* all the Sidonians -- them I will drive out from before the children of Israel; only divide it by lot to Israel as an inheritance, as I have commanded you.

- A. When Joshua was old, there was still land to conquer
- B. God promised to drive them out and commands Joshua to divide it as an inheritance
