Shamgar (Judges 3:31; 5:6)</p> <p>³¹ After him [Ehud] was Shamgar the son of Anath, who killed six hundred men of the Philistines with an ox goad; and he also delivered Israel.</p>	<p>(1) Name: “ _____ ”</p> <p>(2) Time: After Ehud</p> <p>(3) Identity: Son of Anath</p> <p>(4) Work: Killed 600 Philistines with an ox goad</p> <p>(5) Impact: He delivered Israel.</p>
<p>2. Tola (Judges 10:1-2)</p> <p>¹ After Abimelech there arose to save Israel Tola the son of Puah, the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar; and he dwelt in Shamir in the mountains of Ephraim.</p> <p>² He judged Israel twenty-three years; and he died and was buried in Shamir.</p>	<p>(1) Name: “ _____ ”</p> <p>(2) Time: After Abimelech</p> <p>(3) Identity: Son of Puah, the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar</p> <p>(4) Place: Dwelt in Shamir, in the mountains of Ephraim</p> <p>(5) Impact & Length: Judged Israel 23 years.</p>
<p>3. Jair (Judges 10:3-5)</p> <p>³ After him arose Jair, a Gileadite; and he judged Israel twenty-two years.</p> <p>⁴ Now he had thirty sons who rode on thirty donkeys; they also had thirty towns, which are called "Havoth Jair " to this day, which <i>are</i> in the land of Gilead.</p> <p>⁵ And Jair died and was buried in Camon.</p>	<p>(1) Name: “May [God] _____ ”</p> <p>(2) Time: After Tola (who was after Abimelech)</p> <p>(3) Identity: A Gileadite</p> <p>(4) Place: Camon, in Gilead</p> <p>(5) Impact: 30 sons who rode 30 donkeys with 30 towns</p> <p>(6) Length: Judged Israel 22 years.</p>
<p>4. Ibzan (Judges 12:8-10)</p> <p>⁸ After him, Ibzan of Bethlehem judged Israel.</p> <p>⁹ He had thirty sons. And he gave away thirty daughters in marriage, and brought in thirty daughters from elsewhere for his sons. (cp. 3:6)</p> <p>He judged Israel seven years.</p> <p>¹⁰ Then Ibzan died and was buried at Bethlehem.</p>	<p>(1) Name: “ _____ ”</p> <p>(2) Time: After Jephthah</p> <p>(3) Identity: Of Bethlehem</p> <p>(4) Impact: 30 daughters; 30 sons</p> <p>(5) Length: Judged Israel 7 years.</p>
<p>5. Elon (Judges 12:11-12)</p> <p>¹¹ After him, Elon the Zebulunite judged Israel. He judged Israel ten years.</p> <p>¹² And Elon the Zebulunite died and was buried at Aijalon in the country of Zebulun.</p>	<p>(1) Name: “ _____ ” or “Terebrinth”</p> <p>(2) Time: After Ibzan</p> <p>(3) Identity: The Zebulunite</p> <p>(4) Place: Aijalon, in Zebulun</p> <p>(5) Impact & Length: Judged Israel 10 years.</p>
<p>6. Abdon (Judges 12:13-15)</p> <p>¹³ After him, Abdon the son of Hillel the Pirathonite judged Israel.</p> <p>¹⁴ He had forty sons and thirty grandsons, who rode on seventy young donkeys. He judged Israel eight years.</p> <p>¹⁵ Then Abdon the son of Hillel the Pirathonite died and was buried in Pirathon in the land of Ephraim, in the mountains of the Amalekites.</p>	<p>(1) Name: “ _____ ” or “Servant”</p> <p>(2) Time: After Abdon</p> <p>(3) Identity: Son of Hillel the Pirathonite</p> <p>(4) Place: Pirathon, in Ephraim</p> <p>(5) Impact: 40 sons & 30 grandsons on 70 donkeys</p> <p>(6) Length: Judged Israel 8 years.</p>
