

Take a Look!: 5 Promptings from the Lord's Table

1. LOOK AT _____ :

- **Have I Accepted the _____ that Jesus Provided?**

2 Cor 5:21 – For He made Him who knew no sin [to be] sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

- **Do I Follow Jesus' _____ ?**

1 John 3:16 – By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

2. LOOK _____ :

- **Am I _____ What Salvation Is All About?**

Matt 28:20 – teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, [even] to the end of the age." Amen.

- **Am I _____ in the Power & Provisions of Salvation?**

Heb 8:6 – And those [who are] Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

3. LOOK _____ :

- **How I Am _____ ? (Not the Opposite!)**

1 Cor 11:27-34 – Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks [this] cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the **body** and blood of the Lord... Therefore, my brethren, when you come together to eat, wait for one another. But if anyone is hungry, let him eat at home, lest you come together for judgment. And the rest I will set in order when I come.

4. LOOK _____ :

- **Am I _____ Believers as Part of the Body of Christ?**

1 Corinthians 10:15-17 - I speak as to wise men; judge for yourselves what I say. The **cup** of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The **bread** which we break, is it not the communion of the **body** of Christ? For we, [though] many, are one bread [and] one body; for we all partake of that one bread.

- **Am I _____ Those in the Body Of Christ... ?**

Romans 12:4-8 – For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, so we, [being] many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, [let us use them:] if prophecy, [let us prophesy] in proportion to our faith; or ministry, [let us use it] in [our] ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

5. LOOK _____ :

- **Am I Living in View of the _____ of Jesus?**

1 Corinthians 11:26 – For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

1 John 2:28-3:3 And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming. ... 3 And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

- **Am I Living for the _____ Rather than the Temporal?**

Matthew 6:19-21 – Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

1 John 2:15-17 – Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that [is] in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

- **Am I Living In View of Giving an _____ One Day?**

Romans 14:10 – But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you show contempt for your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:10 – For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things [done] in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

Hebrews 6:2 – of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

Hebrews 9:27 – And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,

James 3:1 – My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment.

1 John 4:17 – Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

Hebrews 11:24-26 – By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.
