1.	: To please the One Who made my salvation possible.  Matt 25:23 His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'  Rom 8:8 So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.  1 Thes 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God.  2 Tim 2:4 No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.
2.	: To be able to look forward to Christ's coming.
	1 John 2:28 And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.
3.	: To experience meaningful relationships w/ others
	1 John 1:3 that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship <i>is</i> with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ.
4.	: To help (not hinder) others that I am around.
	<ul> <li>1 Cor 8:12-13 But when you thus sin against the brethren, and wound their weak conscience, you sin against Christ. Therefore, if food makes my brother stumble, I will never again eat meat, lest I make my brother stumble.</li> <li>My Family: They will become like ME!</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>My Church Family: They will only be as effective as I am (team member)</li> <li>My Friends &amp; the World: Am I salt &amp; light? Do I turn people to God or from God?</li> </ul>
5.	: To know what is true/false, right/wrong.
	John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."
	Eph 5:13 But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light.
	1 John 1:5-7 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, tha
	God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. <sup>6</sup> If we say that we have fellowship with Him and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. <sup>7</sup> But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
