

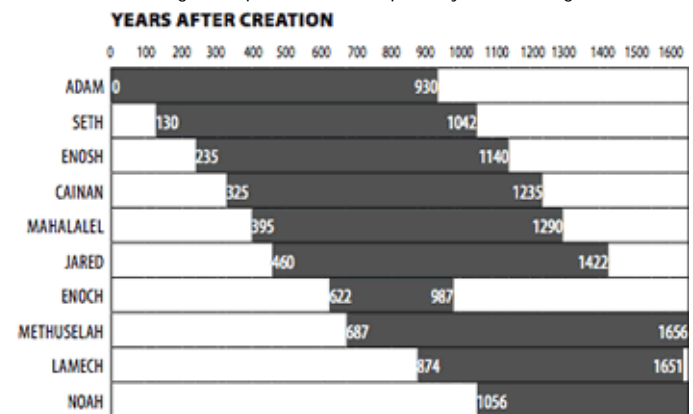
Genesis 5:1-32 – From Adam to Noah – *Lessons from Individuals*

<p>¹ This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God.</p> <p>² He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • States a real genealogy of a real person (Adam). He is not a myth, but a real man who had descendants. • These two verses parallel Genesis 1:26-28. • God created Adam (and Eve), from whom all the earth is descended.
<p>³ And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot <i>a son</i> in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth.</p> <p>⁴ After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters.</p> <p>⁵ So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People produce people. God's image, though infected by sin, still exists. People, created in the image of God, are different than animals. • Adam had [other] sons and daughters, as did all the men in this genealogy. • Adam died, as promised in God's warning. • Adam lived 930 years.
<p>⁶ Seth lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh.</p> <p>⁷ After he begot Enosh, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>⁸ So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Notice this is just one line of descendants from Adam – Seth's line to Noah (without detailing any other descendants but that direct line to Noah). • Seth lived 912 years.
<p>⁹ Enosh lived ninety years, and begot Cainan.</p> <p>¹⁰ After he begot Cainan, Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>¹¹ So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enosh lived 905 years.
<p>¹² Cainan lived seventy years, and begot Mahalalel.</p> <p>¹³ After he begot Mahalalel, Cainan lived eight hundred and forty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>¹⁴ So all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cainan lived 910 years.
<p>¹⁵ Mahalalel lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared.</p> <p>¹⁶ After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>¹⁷ So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mahalalel lived 895 years.
<p>¹⁸ Jared lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch.</p> <p>¹⁹ After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>²⁰ So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jared lived 962 years.
<p>²¹ Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah.</p> <p>²² After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>²³ So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years.</p> <p>²⁴ And Enoch walked with God; and he <i>was</i> not, for God took him.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It was possible to walk with God during this time. • Enoch lived 365 years. • Enoch did not die. God seemingly transported him into His presence (one of the very few that did not die).
<p>²⁵ Methuselah lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech.</p> <p>²⁶ After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>²⁷ So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Methuselah lived 969 years. • Methuselah has the recorded as the oldest human being in the Bible.
<p>²⁸ Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son.</p> <p>²⁹ And he called his name Noah, saying, "This <i>one</i> will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed."</p> <p>³⁰ After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>³¹ So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years; and he died.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All of Lamech's ancestors above were still alive for some time after he was born! • Lamech is the father of Noah. • Lamech gave Noah his name for a specific reason, expecting Noah ("rest") to bring comfort to humanity. • Lamech lived a "short" 777 years.
<p>³² And Noah was five hundred years old, and Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Noah had at least 3 sons. • Except for Adam, Seth, & Enoch, Noah's ancestors above were alive at his birth.

<p>¹⁵ Mahalalel lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared.</p> <p>¹⁶ After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>¹⁷ So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died.</p>
<p>¹⁸ Jared lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch.</p> <p>¹⁹ After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>²⁰ So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died.</p>
<p>²¹ Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah.</p> <p>²² After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>²³ So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years.</p> <p>²⁴ And Enoch walked with God; and he <i>was</i> not, for God took him.</p>
<p>²⁵ Methuselah lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech.</p> <p>²⁶ After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters.</p> <p>²⁷ So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years; and he died.</p>

1. The Bible is a real book about real people.
2. Genesis 5 lists real people by specific details.
 - a. Name
 - b. Years lived until the person's first child was born
 - c. Name of first child
 - d. Years lived after first child was born
 - e. Summary of one's life ("had sons and daughters")
 - f. Total number of years lived
 - g. End of the person ("and he died," except for Enoch).
3. People propagated, being fruitful and multiplying.
 - a. God's command & blessing (Gen 1:28)
 - b. All spouses originally came from Adam and Eve.
 - c. The population expanded (this is only a list of one person in each generation).
4. People lived much longer before the Flood.
 - a. Adam – 930 years.
 - b. Seth – 912 years.
 - c. Enosh – 905 years.
 - d. Cainan – 910 years.
 - e. Mahalael – 895 years.
 - f. Jared – 962 years.
 - g. Enoch – 365 years.* (*God took him)
 - h. Methuselah – 969 years.
 - i. Lamech – 777 years.
 - j. Noah...
5. Longer lifespans impacted the world and relationships.
 - a. Because of the longer lifespans, the population would have grown much more quickly, as people didn't die as soon, and likely had much larger families.
 - b. Because of the longer lifespans, one could possibly know 8-10 generations.



6. God's warning to Adam (Gen 2) came true for him and his descendants. ("The day you eat of it you shall surely die.")
