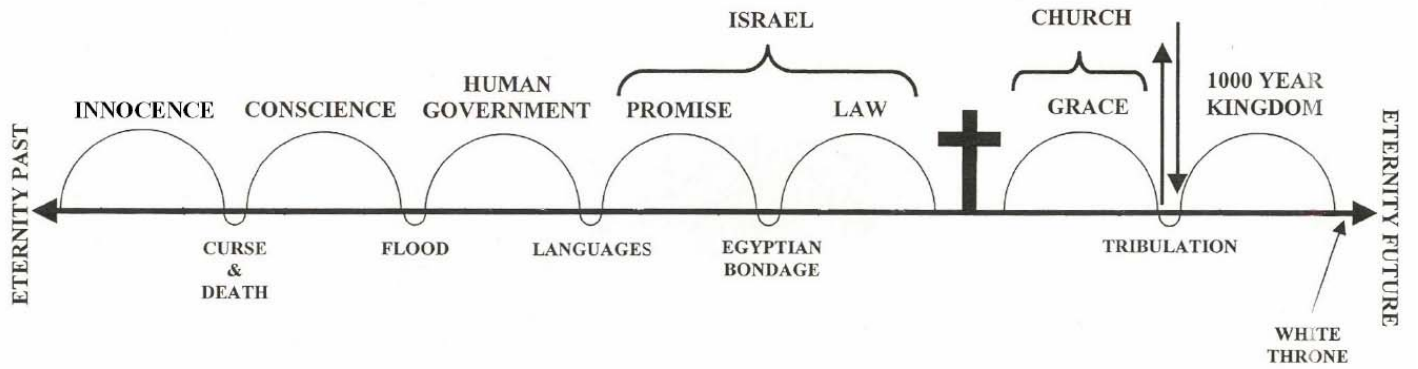


Timeline of Truth – God Makes a Covenant with Noah (Genesis 8:20 – 9:17)

<p>³ "Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you. I have given you all things, even as the green herbs. ⁴ "But you shall not eat flesh with its life, <i>that is</i>, its blood.</p>	<p><i>#2: Every Moving Animal Given for _____</i> <i>Prior to this, humans/animals had a vegetarian diet (Gen 1:29-30):</i> <i>And God said, "See, I have given you every herb [that] yields seed which [is] on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which [there is] life, [I have given] every green herb for food"; and it was so.</i></p>
<p>⁵ "Surely for your lifeblood I will demand <i>a reckoning</i>; from the hand of every beast I will require it, and from the hand of man. <p>⁸ Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying: ⁹ "And as for Me, behold, I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you, ¹⁰ "and with every living creature that <i>is</i> with you: the birds, the cattle, and every beast of the earth with you, of all that go out of the ark, every beast of the earth. ¹¹ "Thus I establish My covenant with you: Never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth." ¹² And God said: "This <i>is</i> the sign of the covenant which I make between Me and you, and every living creature that <i>is</i> with you, for perpetual generations: ¹³ "I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth. ¹⁴ "It shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud; ¹⁵ "and I will remember My covenant which <i>is</i> between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh. ⁶ "The rainbow shall be in the cloud, and I will look on it to remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that <i>is</i> on the earth." ¹⁷ And God said to Noah, "This <i>is</i> the sign of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that <i>is</i> on the earth."</p>	<p>God _____ on His Covenant with Noah</p> <p><i>Who the Covenant Is Between (9-10):</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God • Noah & Noah's descendants • Every living creature (birds, cattle, beast) <p><i>What the Covenant Involves (11-17):</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Never will God cut off all flesh by a world-wide flood (11,15) • The covenant is an everlasting covenant (16) • The covenant is between God and every living creature of flesh that is on the earth (16-17) <p><i>What God Gave as a Sign (12-17):</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sign will be rainbow (12-13) • Sign will remind God of His covenant (14-16) • Sign is visible indication of God's covenant between Him and all flesh that is on the earth (17)
